I- Housing and construction challenges: China

- Major urbanization shift for the last 30 years
 - -2011: more urbanites than rurals for the first time
 - -more than 260 million migrant workers to get house

Construction quantity driven





I- Housing and construction challenges: China

- Deceleration of urban growth (2.6%)
- Higher income

Demand for better quality housing





I- Housing and construction challenges: China

- Environmental concern
 - -air pollution killing 1 million people per year
 - -tougher regulations adopted by authorities

(Winter 2017, no major construction in Beijing to prevent pollution- dust-)

Demand for greener housing





- High urban rate
- Demand for higher quality housing
- Demand for more energy efficient construction

Germany

- Strong demand on the housing market
 Until 2020: at least 350,000 new dwellings per year
- Energiewende: plan to reduce energy consumption subtask: make housing more energy efficient: from passive to active
- Objective for 2050: 80% reduction of energy consumption of housing stock since 2014





France

- Objective for 2025: 25% of public housing (2016: 19%)
- Objective for 2020: 38% reduction of energy consumption in the construction sector since 2013
- 2040: 5 billion euros to make housing more energy efficient





Netherlands

- Local govs to boost social housing
 (Amsterdam: 40% of new homes to be rent-controlled)
- Promotion low carbon housing
 Amsterdam: 2020: new housing to be energy-neutral






Slum issue

 Chad 88%, Mozambique 80%






Slum population in urban Africa
